Back in April, 4 online IRS Forums were hosted in Ireland, Spain, France and Portugal with +120 online participants from all across Europe. These forums serve as a public presentation of the project and introduction of our priority areas and activities.

B2I WORKSHOPS: Blue Biotech Innovation Workshops

During June and September, a series of 6 regional workshops were held in Galicia, Pais Vasco, Canarias, France, Portugal and Ireland including key companies from MARINNONET's partners ecosystem.

More than 100 participants, including 13 Universities, 32 companies, 11 public entities and 6 representants of public society participated in these events, gathering more than 150 challenges/opportunities.

These workshops aimed at understanding the needs of industrial and academics, society and public entities working in the Blue Biotech towards developing connections and future projects and boost innovation. The workshops ended with an online **transregional workshop** where our experts explained all inputs gathered in the regional events.







MARINNONET Pilot Projects

With the challenges, contacts and knowledge gathered in the workshops, MARINNONET launched its first call for Pilot Projects, covering our three priority areas. Selected Pilot Projects will be R&D&I activities in the TRL3-7 range (max 12 months duration), corresponding to feasibility studies, exploitation or demonstration projects.

A total of **9 projects were approved** each one composed by minimum 2 organizations of the consortium and a company, **3** aligned with the thematic priority related to Aquaculture, **1** related to Omic Technologies and Observation and **5** to Industrial products.

Projects are starting January of 2025, great things lay ahead for MARINNONET!

2025 Next steps

MARINNONET team is making steady progress with concrete actions to enhance our network and build this new community.

The 2025 plan is structured around community actions and the second call for Pilot Projects:

- May 2025: IRS Forums and Workshops, regional and transregional events.
- September 2025: next 2nd call for Pilot Projects.
